1 - Weatheroak Bee's Knees - 3.70% Pale Gold Bitter

A GOLDEN ale brewed to 3.7% ABV. A light and refreshing ale with a hint of honey.



25 miles

2 - Church End Goats Milk - 3.80% Deep Gold Bitter

Golden yellow nectar. Pale Barley, crystal malt and oats blend to fill the palate with flavour. Aromatic hops dance over the tongue for a gentle hop finish. Please note no goats are sacrificed in the production of this beer. Supreme Champion Beer of Britain 2017

3 - Green Duck Bostin' Bitter - 3.80% Deep Amber Bitter

Nice fruity aroma taste with a nice bitter finish. Smooth and easy drinking session ale. Get it if you get the chance.

4 - Woodcote X P A - 3.90% Pale Gold Pale Ale or IPA

Fruity, light and very tasty Extra Pale Ale.

5 - AJ's Ales Dukeys Delight - 4.10% Pale Amber Pale Ale or IPA

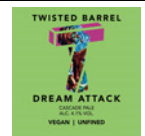
Named after the head brewer this pale ale really is Dukey's Delight using top quality hops from around the world tasting very hoppy and bitter with lots of fruity flavours.

6 - Twisted Barrel Dream Attack - 4.10% Straw Pale Ale or IPA V

A fresh American Pale brewed solely with Cascade hops for notes of lemon and grapefruit and a balanced bitterness. Unfined.

7 - Beowulf Mango Sybian - 4.30% Pale Gold Pale Ale or IPA

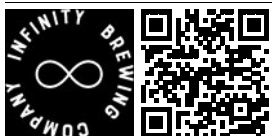
(pronounced 'sippian') is the newest beer in the Beowulf range. Sybian translates as 'to sip or drink' in Old English. It has bursts of juicy mango, combined with a tropical hoppy aroma. This is a pale ale which is refreshing and moderately dry on the palate, with a smooth and delicately bitter finish.

8 - Trinity Lichfield West Coast Pale - 4.30% Straw Pale Ale or IPA V

West coast pale with Idaho 7 and Strata

9 - Infinity Perspective - 4.40% Deep Brown Mild V

A smooth and satisfying dark mild with malty biscuit and minimal bitterness. Lightly fined with vegan finings (protosol) , allergens: Barley (gluten)

10 - Brew 61 Black Bull Rye IPA - 4.50% Deep Amber Pale Ale or IPA

Rich, dark and malty with subtle spice and a bold citrus finish

11 - Copper Beech Birdie - 4.60% Straw Pale Ale or IPA

An American Pale Ale blending Maris Otter, Carapils and Light Crystal malts to maintain its character and support the show-stopping hop Simcoe. The hop bill brings citrus flavours, grapefruit being prominent, with a pine undertone. At 4.6% it is still a fairly sessionable beer.
Malts: Maris Otter and Dextrin; Hops: Simcoe

12 - Wye Valley Talisman - 4.70% Ruby Brown Golden Ale

Full-bodied, copper coloured and with the charms of Herefordshire hops, serving this brew on your bar is surely a symbol of great taste!

13 - Infinity Smash - 5.00% Deep Gold Pale Ale or IPA V

A single malt, single hop pale ale brewed with pilsner malt and citra hops. Crisp with aromas of lemon and grapefruit. Unfiltered - allergens: Barley (gluten)

14 - Hook Norton Flagship - 5.30% Medium Amber Pale Ale or IPA

A proper India Pale Ale with a fruity mouth feel and a distinctive sweet aroma and powerful hop punch.

15 - Trinity Accept All Cookies - 9.00% Deep Brown Porter & Stout

Our imperial stout made in collaboration with State of Kind Brewery, had 15Kg of broken biscuits added to the mash giving it a rich chocolate flavour with subtle biscuit notes

16 - Hogan's Hazy Rays - 3.90% Deep Gold Medium Sweet Cider V/GF/H

A deliciously light, fruity and moreish fresh pressed hazy cider. This best seller carries an abundant apple aroma to the nose. With more than a hint of citrus and berry delicately balanced against the apple sweetness on the palate, Hazy Rays is the perfect refreshing session drink for those lazy summer days.

17 - Barbourne Cherry Bakewell Cider - 4.00% Pink Fruit Cider V/GF

20 - Hogan's Harvest Press - 5.30% Deep Gold Medium Dry Cider V/GF/H

A distinctively fresh bittersweet, still, cloudy cider. Appley aroma with peaty undertones, this medium dry cider is just challenging enough to be easy drinking. A real taste of the orchard for those ready to embrace proper cider.

21 - Barbourne Traditional Worcestershire Cider - 6.00% Pale Gold Medium Cider V/GF/H

This hazy medium cider was developed for the famous Worcestershire cider pub The Anchor. It is a smooth and easy drop of good.

22 - Hogan's Libertine - 6.20% Deep Gold Medium Sweet Cider V/GF

This indulgent and sweetly satisfying blend is a radical renegade of a cider. Burnt umber in colour, it's rich, dark and tannic with a delicious depth of flavour that's as warm as it is wild.

23 - Sandford Orchards Apple and Oak - 6.70% Pale Gold Dry Cider V/GF

Fresh Oak-Finished Cider. A dry vintage cider aged in new oak barrels. Showcasing youthful, ripe, bittersweet apple flavours – complemented by notes of vanilla and toasty oak. Key Apple Varieties: Browns, Northwood, Sweet Coppin.

24 - Barbourne Oak Cask - 7.40% Deep Gold Dry Cider V/GF

Our Oak Cask Cider has been fermented and conditioned in freshly emptied Whisky Casks to achieve a deep and full flavoured dry cider. Gluten Free, Unfiltered, Unfined, Vegan, Vegetarian

25 - Sandford Orchards The General - 8.40% Pale Gold Medium Dry Cider V/GF

The General is our tribute to the legendary Sir Redvers Buller, a warrior Devonian and one of Britain's most decorated military leaders. Our finest vintage cider is aged in our mighty, 100 year old oak vat, nicknamed 'The General'. Powerful and complex with rich apple fruit, honey, vanilla and hints of malted barley



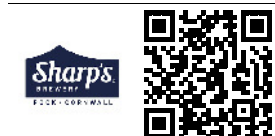

26 - Wye Valley HPA - 4.00% Pale Straw Pale Ale or IPA

HPA is an easy-going real ale that brings people together. Our brewers have let locally grown Target and Celeia hops hang out with Maris Otter pale malt to give this understated brew its pale straw colour, citrus hop aroma and a balanced bitter finish.

28 - Sharps Atlantic Pale Ale - 4.20% Pale Gold Pale Ale or IPA

Succulence from two types of malt, tropical and citrus fruits from new world hops. It's deep golden in colour with the aroma of stunning citrus notes, juicy tropical fruits and fresh-picked hops with a touch of candy floss. The flavour has a delicate sweetness with fruity succulence and citrus spice to the fore. The finish is sweet at first becoming dry and lingering with hop zest. All this, along with Sharp's trademark complexity and balance, give a beautifully refreshing pale ale.

29 - Hook Norton Off The Hook - 4.30% Pale Straw Pale Ale or IPA

A strong combination of citrus and orange notes delivering a full on refreshing.
See: Pale; Smell: Citrus fruits; Taste: Orange and citrus

30 - Wye Valley Butty Bach - 4.50% Deep Gold Bitter

Butty Bach is a Welsh term meaning 'little friend' – and this charmingly smooth premium ale has certainly made more than a few friendships in its time. We brew it using Maris Otter and Crystal malts together with locally grown Fuggles, Goldings and Bramling Cross hops. With such fine ingredients, no wonder it remains a firm favourite.

32 - Sharps Sea Fury - 5.00% Pale Gold Old Ale

Sea Fury is an exceptional example of the Special Bitter beer style, offering substance and depth of flavour without compromising balance and drinkability. An aroma of inviting roasted and dark berry notes gives way to sumptuous, fruity, malty flavour and a moreish hop finish.
Aroma: Inviting roasted and dark berry notes.

32 - Sharps Solar Wave - 4.60% Pale Gold Pale Ale or IPA V/H

Sharp's Brewery Solar Wave is a vibrant, golden, juicy, hazy IPA brewed to hit the sweet spot between fruitiness and hop bitterness and become a new favourite at the bar. Big, tropical hop aromas, lower fizz and a distinctive golden haze are accompanied by a taste that's bursting with juicy hop flavours, like zesty tangerine and zingy pineapple. Born hazy, brewed juicy, this beer is created by a passionate bunch of brewers and beer lovers on the North Cornish coast.
